Criteria for being on the List of Hill-Breeders 2019/2020

6 inside the National Park with full criteria.

- 1. They have grazing rights for (Fell) ponies on the common land.
- 2. They are an active grazer of Registered Fell Ponies in a breeding herd.
- 3. The number of breeding mares in a herd is 5 or over, hopefully with different bloodlines. (separate data to show most hill herds are not breeding enough from rarer bloodlines)

The first 11 Breeding herds cover all 3 points for the Criteria.

Top group of breeders with over 10 plus mares.

- 1. Bybeck at Orton with 20 plus mares of breeding age running on Howgills. Foaling in-bye.
- 2. Greenholme at Shap with 25 mares of breeding age running on Birkbeck common. Foaling inbye. Inside the National Park.
- 3. Drybarrows at Bampton with 15 mares of breeding age running on Bampton common and foaling mostly on the common. Inside the National Park.
- 4. Wansfell at Troutbeck has 11 breeding mares running on Wansfell Pike, foaling in-bye. Inside the National Park.
- 5. Wellbrow nr Rochdale, Lancashire. has 40 plus breeding mares running on Wardle and Shore Moor.
- 6. Lownthwaite at Gamblesby has 20 plus breeding mares running on Milburn Common.
- 7. Townend at Hesket Newmarket with 18 breeding mares running on Caldbeck Common/Carrock Fell. Foaling in-bye. Inside the National Park.
- 8. Ashbeck at Ravenstonedale has 15 breeding mares running on Wildboar Fell.
- 9. Dalehead at Askham has 8 breeding mares running on Barton Fell. Inside the National Park.
- 10. Kinniside at Cleator Moor with 7 breeding mares running on Flat Fell. Inside the National Park.
- 11. Dalewin at Ravenstonedale with 8 breeding mares running on Ravenstonedale common.

Hill-breeders with 5 breeding mares or less.

2 more breeders inside the National Park, making 8 herds.

- 12. Peepings with 4 mares running on Dufton fell.
- 13. Rundales with 3 mares running on Dufton fell.
- 14. Stennerskeugh with 4 mares running on Wildboar Fell.
- 15. Ashamgate with 4 mares running on Moor Divock. Inside the National Park.
- 16. Globetrotter with 4 mares running on Roundthwaite Common. Inside the National Park.
